Grant Funding Guidelines

- Applications due by August 1 by 5 p.m.

Qualifications

- Exempt under Section 501(c)(3) of the IRS code
- Located in Dallas County

Eligible Projects

- Align with at least one of our focus areas: housing, education, job creation, environment
- Utilize the professional expertise, skills and resources of our members (i.e. architectural, design, legal services, financial/accounting, title services, construction, engineering services, etc.)
- Involve real estate or real estate-based economic development
- Ready to start the project and plan to complete in approximately one year
- Impact under-served neighborhoods

PLEASE NOTE: TREC Foundation will not fund requests for non-real estate related items such as operations, staffing, furniture, equipment, studies, marketing or mentoring.
